The five candidates selected will receive a complimentary registration (not including banquet expenses) to the convention.

J.S. Bach: *Wachet auf, ruft uns die Stimme*, BWV 645

J.S. Bach: *Fugue in G minor ("Little")* BWV 578

Sigfrid Karg-Elert: *Marche Triomphale, Now Thank We All Our God*, Op.65, no. 59

Jospeh Rheinberger: *First Movement*, from *Sonata in G*, Op. 88

Percy Whitlock: *Allegretto (No. 1)* from *Five Short Pieces*

Louis Vierne: *Scherzetto*, from *24 Pieces in Free style*

Interested students are asked to complete the application and return with your tape of the following. Tapes will be evaluated by a team of independent organists. Candidates will be notified May 30, 2003. A scholarship of convention registration is offered to successful candidates

Any chorale prelude from Bach's Orgelbüchlein

A piece of contrasting character from the nineteenth or twentieth centuries (with pedals)
