Dear Colleagues,

A really big thank you to Maris Kristapsons who sorted all the music and offered it to all of us. The sale was a huge success. We added over \$500 to our scholarship

fund! In addition many of us added new music to our libraries at a fraction of the usual cost. It was a win – win for everyone.

You should also be aware of the outcome of our Patriotic Hymn Sing and concert from last November. We had a wonderful crowd and raised about \$3,000 which was donated to local Veterans groups. Please don't wait until the last minute. Contact Barbara soon while your Advent/Christmas music is still fresh in your mind and so she can start organizing this.

The year is off to a "great" start. Let's keep it that way.


