I recorded this last night, just a few hours before she departed. The text of this chorale "When in the Hour of Utmost Need" is a prayer containing these words:

Then this our comfort is alone, That we may meet before Thy throne, And cry, O faithful God, to Thee...

I thank everyone for their continued prayers and support. My mother and all of us have been blessed being surrounded by loved ones and friends!
